

RESOLUTION NO. 179/2014-CEPE, AUGUST 7, 2014.

Approves criteria for the distribution of Master's and Doctoral scholarships granted by the Capes Social Demand Program (DS) - PRPPG quota.

THE TEACHING, RESEARCH AND EXTENSION COUNCIL of the Western Paraná State University (Unioeste), in an ordinary meeting held on August 7, 2014, together with the Dean in the exercise of his statutory and regimental attributions;

Considering that which is contained in CR n° 42665/2014, May 16, 2014;

ESTABLISHES THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS:

Art. 1st To approve, according to the annex to this Resolution, criteria for the internal distribution of Master's and Doctoral scholarships granted by the Social Demand Program (DS) of the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel (Capes) - PRPPG quota.

Art. 2nd The criteria referred to in art. 1st refer to Master's and Doctoral scholarships within the quota of the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies (PRPPG), per determinations of the Social Demand Program (DS) of the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel (Capes).

Art. 3rd This Resolution will be effective as of August 7, 2014.

CHAPTER I

SCHOLARSHIP DISTRIBUTION

Section I

Master's Scholarships

Art. 1st Master's scholarships are distributed on a rotating basis among the *stricto sensu* Graduate Programs that have a Master's degree course in the academic modality, according to the reverse order of the course's seniority, with new courses being given priority.

§1 The course's seniority is gauged on the basis of the starting date of its academic activities, characterized by the beginning of course (subject) offers.

§2 Each contemplated Program will be granted up to 24 months of scholarship.

§3 Scholarships destined for the Program but not implemented until the deadline for Capes registration return to the distribution pool, to be allocated in the subsequent month.

Section II

Doctorate Scholarships

Art. 2nd Doctoral scholarships are distributed on a rotating basis among the *stricto sensu* Graduate Programs that have a doctoral course in the academic modality in question,

according to the reverse order of course seniority, with new courses being given priority.

§1 The course's seniority is gauged on the basis of the starting date of its academic activities, characterized by the beginning of course (subject) offers.

§2 Each contemplated Program will be granted up to 48 months of scholarship.

§3 Scholarships destined for the Program but not implemented until the deadline for Capes registration return to the distribution pool, to be allocated in the subsequent month.

CHAPTER III

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Art. 3rd After the end of the concession, all other Programs must have been covered before the Program in question may again benefit from a scholarship in the PRPPG quota.

Art. 4th networked Graduate Programs, associate Programs whose headquarters are not at Unioeste, and Master's degrees in the professional modality are not covered by this Resolution.

Art. 5th The granting of Master's and Doctoral scholarships must follow the current legislation as well as Capes and Unioeste regulations, as is subjected to quota availability.

Art. 6th The PRPPG is responsible for publishing and maintaining an up-to-date list of Master's and Doctorate courses.
